





Designed Central Park in New York City






Emmeline Pankhurst

- Founded Women's Social and Political Union (WSPU)





- Came up with the Ballet The Rite of Spring (It shocked the world when it premiered)





There's nothing enlightened about shrinking so that other people won't feel insecure around you.


We were born to make manifest the glory of God that is within us.
