

- *FOREVER CHANGED THE MAP OF EUROPE*

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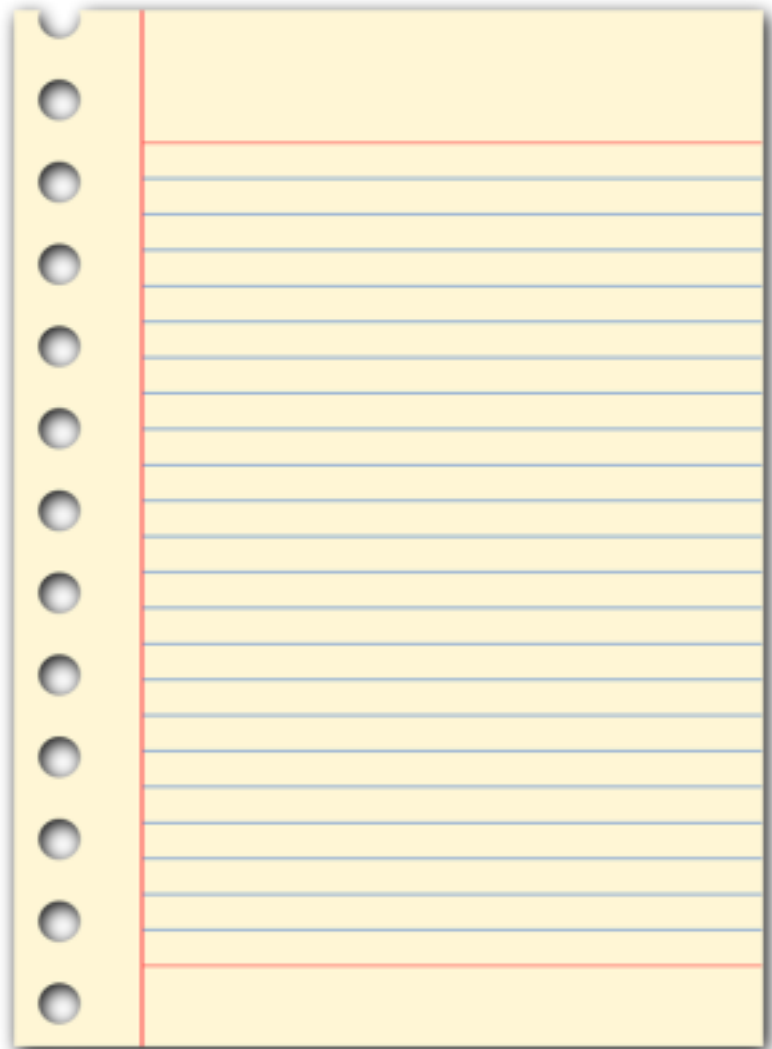

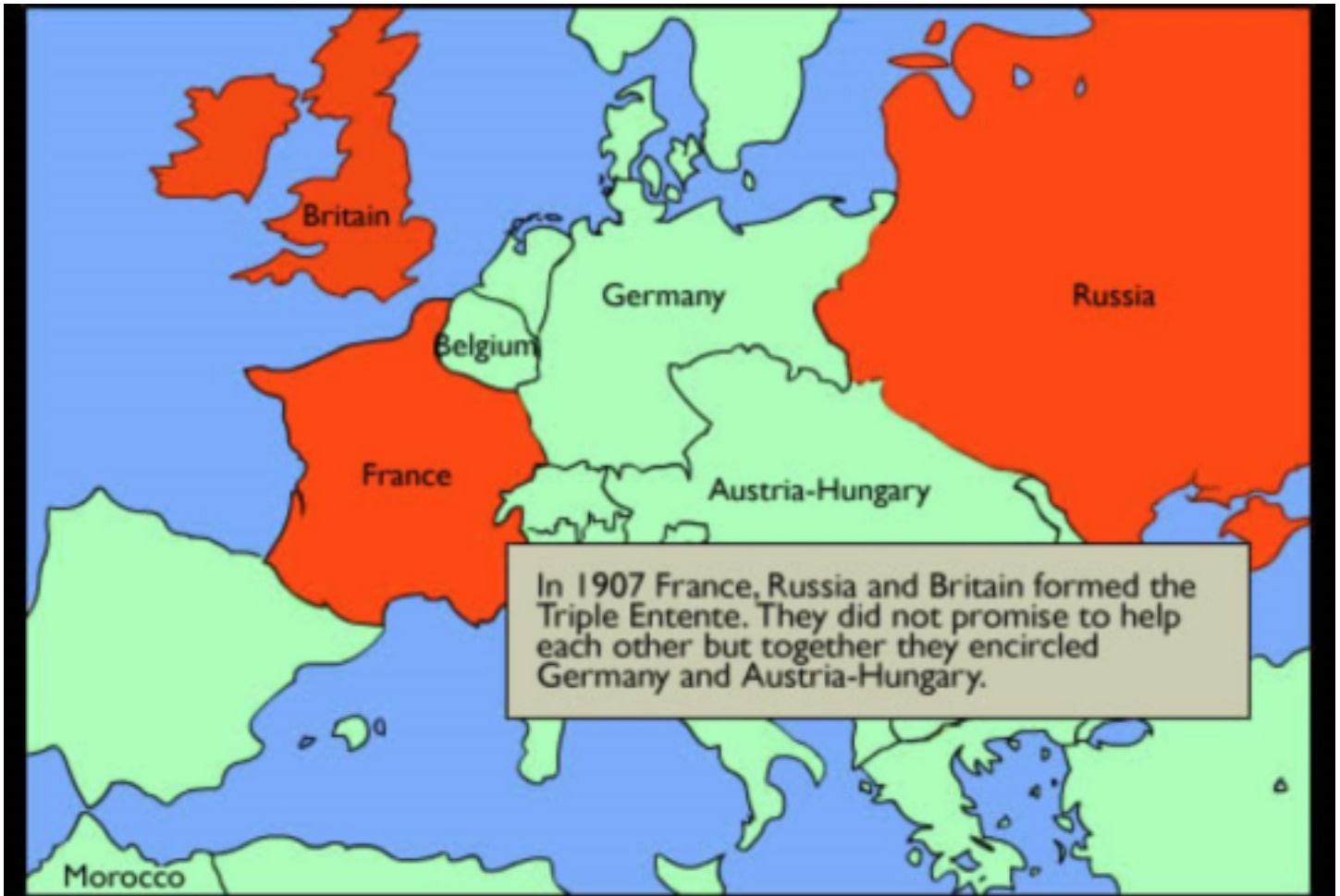
- **Militarism** – Many countries competing to have the biggest military

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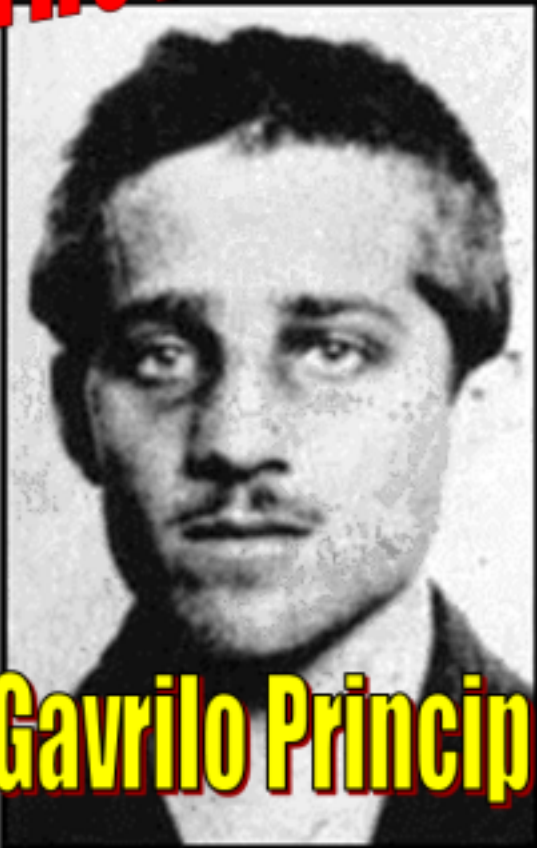
THE SPARK THAT LIT THE FUSE....

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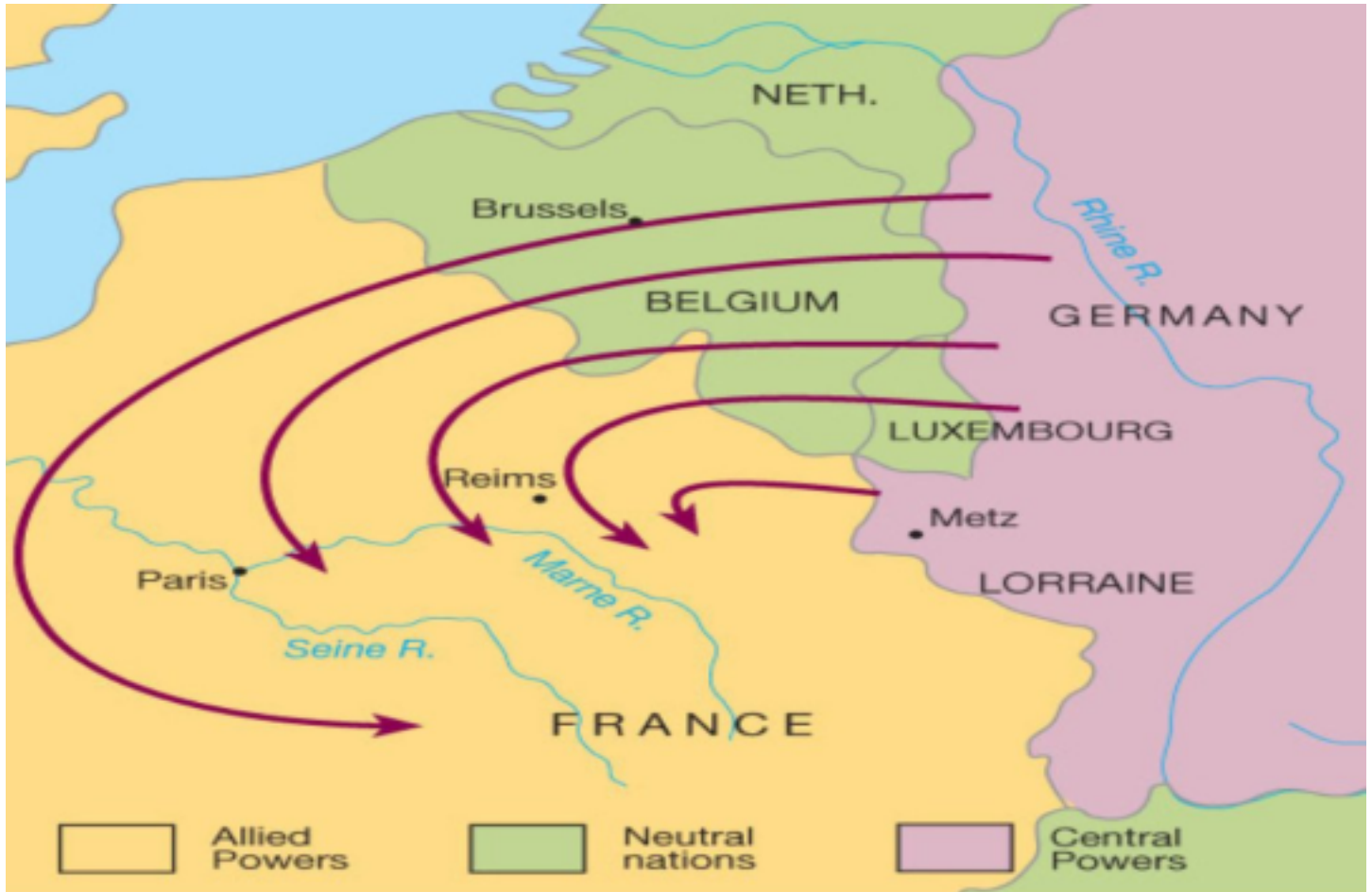

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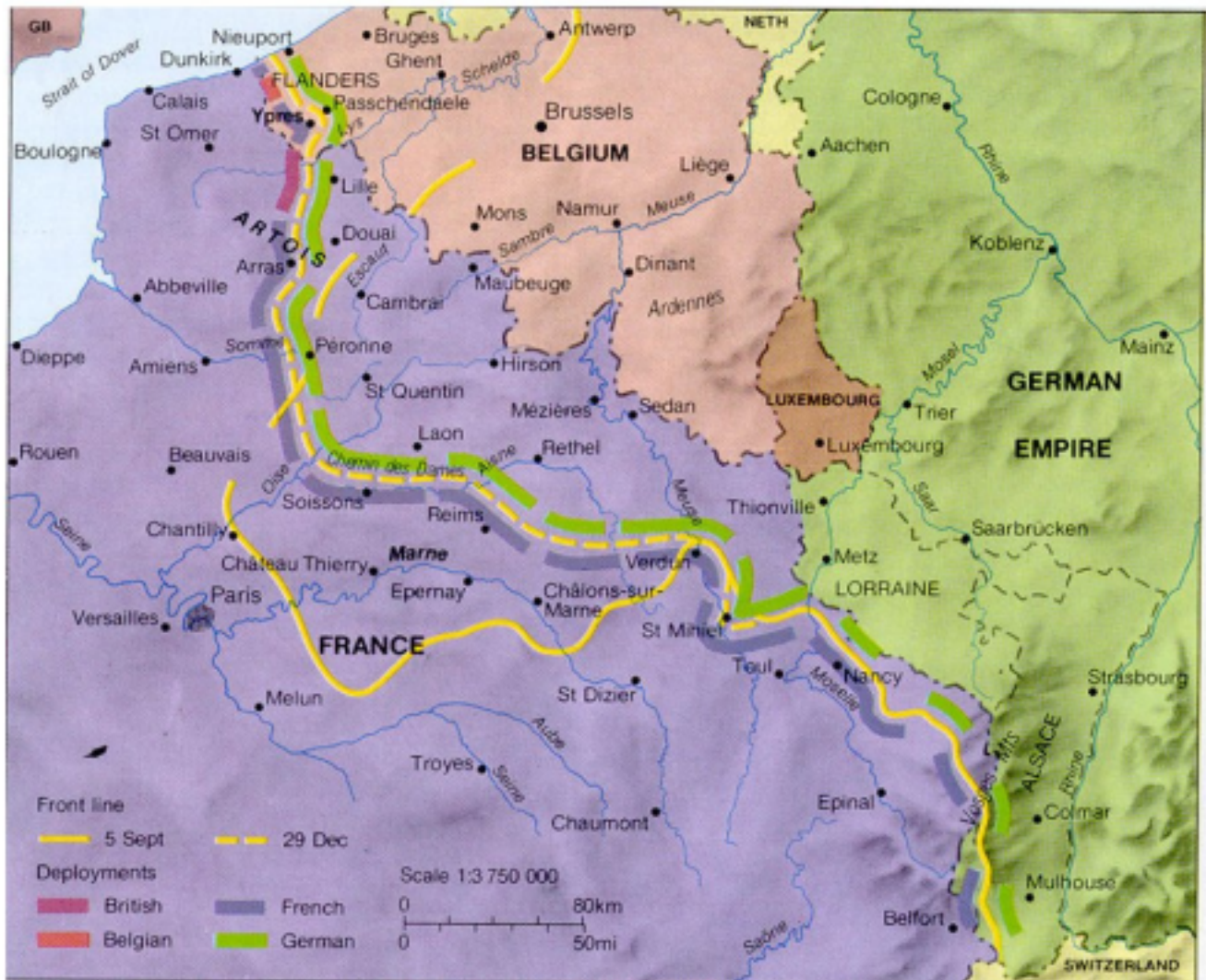

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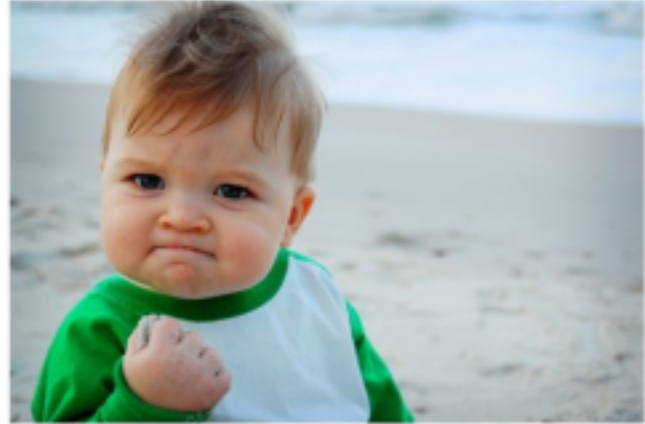
